

An Angel's Love Baby Blanket

Level: Easy/Intermediate

For this project, you will need :

4 skeins of Vanna's Choice by Lion Brand in shade Light Blue (or any other yarn in Aran/Worsted weight)

1 skein of Sirdar Supersoft in Aran, shade 831 (or any other cream yarn in Aran)

1 skein of any cream of DK/Light 3 yarn

A 6,5 mm and a 4 mm crochet hook

A tapestry needle

A pair of scissors

Abbreviations:

I will be writing in US terms

ch: chain

sk: skip

SC: Single Crochet

DC: Double Crochet

HDC: Half Double Crochet

TC: Treble Crochet

Sl st: Slip stitch

Begin pattern:

With a 6,5 mm hook using Vanna's Choice yarn, chain 95

Row 1: Ch.2, counts as 1st HDC, HDC in every stitch until end of row.

Row 2: Ch.2 (counts as 1st HDC), turn your work, HDC in every stitch until end of row (making sure you do not forget to HDC into the ch. 3 from previous row).

Row 3-64: Repeat row 2.

Fasten off

Border:

Row 1: attach Sirdar Supersoft in Aran, using 6,5 mm hook, ch.1, and SC into every stitch all along the four sides of your blanket, sl. st. to first ch.1 to join.

Row 2: ch.3 (counts as 1st DC), place 6 more DC into that first stitch (=7 DC that forms the first shell); [sk. 3 ch., 7 DC into 4th SC, sk. 3 DC] around the whole blanket, sl. st. to first ch. 3 to join. Fasten off.

To make feathers:

Feather 1 (make 1):

With DK yarn, and 4 mm crochet hook, ch.22. SC into 3rd ch. from hook; HDC in next 3 st., DC in next 3 st., TC in next 6 st., DC in next 3 st., HDC in next 3 st., SC in last stitch.

Turn your work so as to work on the other side of your original chain, and SC in 1st SC, HDC in next 3 st., DC in next 3 st., TC in next 6 st., DC in next 3 st., HDC in next 3 st., SC into last st.

Sl. st. into SC from beginning, and ch. 4; sl. St into 2nd ch and into the next 2 ch, sl. Stitching into the last SC from the “body” of the feather, fasten off (leaving long tail to sew onto project).

Feather 2 (make 2): Ch.15, SC in 2nd ch., HDC in next 2 chains, DC in next 3 ch., TC in next 4 ch., DC in next 2 ch., HDC in next st., SC in last st.

Turn work to work on the other side of foundation chain, SC in SC, HDC in next st., DC in next 2 st., TC in next 4 ch., DC in next 3 ch., HDC in next 2 chains, SC in last ch. Sl st. in first SC to join “body” of feather; ch. 3, sl. st. in 2nd ch, and into the next (2 slip stitches), and sl. st. into “body” of feather to join, fasten off (leaving long tail to sew onto project).

Sew feathers onto project:

Choose best corner onto which you wish to place feathers, sew feathers into place (going round at least twice to make sure they are securely attached).

Sew in all loose ends, and you’re done!
