

Easy and stylish crochet man scarf (easy pattern)

You will need :

- 3 skeins of James C Brett's "TUSCANY" chunky yarn in colour TU1
- A 6.5 mm hook
- A pair of scissors
- A tapestry needle (to weave in ends)

Abbreviations (I will be using US terms):

Sl st : slip stitch

SC : Single crochet (UK double)

DC : Double crochet (UK Treble)

Ch : chain

To start :

Make a slip knot, and chain 26

Row 1 : SC in 2nd ch from the hook ; *DC in next ch, SC in next ch*; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Row 2 : Turn your work ; ch 3 (counts as our first DC) ; *SC in next stitch, DC in next stitch* ; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Row 3 : Turn your work, ch 1 (counts as our first SC) ; *DC in next stitch, SC in next stitch ; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Row 4+ : Repeat rows 2 and 3 until the scarf measures approximately 160 cm/ 64 inches (or as long as you want it to be).
