

Autumn Leaves Headband/Ear Warmer

The Pattern:

Level: Easy/beginner

Gauge: 10x10 cm (4 in.x 4 in) = 10 stitches across and 6 rows

Notes :

I will be using US terms (British terms in brackets)

You will need :

- 1 skein of Lion Brand's Landscapes in shade Tropics (or any other shade/yarn in Aran weight yarn)
- A 6.5 mm crochet hook
- A pair of scissors
- A tapestry needle

Abbreviations :

Sl st : slip stitch

HDC: Half Double crochet (UK Half Treble)

Ch : chain

To begin:

To start, make a slip knot.

Ch. 13

R.1 : ch.2 (counts as HDC throughout), HDC in next stitch, and HDC until end of row (=14 HDC)

R.2 : ch.2, HDC in 2nd stitch, HDC until end of row (=14 HDC)

R.3-13 : Repeat row 2

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew both ends of project to create ear warmer.

To make top of ear warmer : Choose the part that you want to be the top of your ear warmer, and scrunch up that part. With a piece of yarn and tapestry needle, sew that scrunched up part back and forth about 6 times to create center fold. Tie a knot when you are happy with it, tidy up all loose ends.
