

Easy Pastel Ribbed Scarf

The Pattern:

Level: Easy/beginner

Gauge: 10x10 cm (4 in.x 4 in) = 12 DC across and 6 rows

Notes :

I will be using US terms (British terms in brackets)

You will need :

- 2 skeins of Caron Baby Cakes in shade Ballerina (or any other shade/yarn in Aran weight yarn)
- A 5 mm crochet hook
- A pair of scissors
- A tapestry needle

Abbreviations :

Sl st : slip stitch

DC: Double crochet (UK Treble Crochet)

Ch : chain

To begin:

To start, make a slip knot.

Ch. 334

R.1 : DC in 4th ch. from hook (first ch 3 counts as DC throughout), DC into each ch until end of row.

R.2 : ch. 3, turn your work, DC back loops only into each DC from previous row.

R.3-10 : repeat row 2.

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew both ends of project to create cowl. Tidy up all loose ends.
