

The Beautiful Gypsy Wrap

The Pattern:

Level: Easy/beginner

Gauge: 4 rounds = 7,5" (19 cm) wide on 3,5" (9 cm) in length. Please note gauge is not crucial for the completion of this project.

Notes :

I will be using US terms (British terms in brackets)

You will need :

- 4 skeins of Lion Brand's Landscapes in shade Cabana (or any other shade/yarn in Aran weight yarn)
- A 6,5 mm crochet hook
- A pair of scissors
- A tapestry needle

Abbreviations :

Sl st : slip stitch

DC: Double crochet (UK Treble)

Ch : chain

To begin:

To start, make a slip knot. Ch.4, sl.st. through 1st stitch to form a ring.

R. 1: Ch.3 (counts as a DC), 4 DC inside center of ring, ch.2, 5 DC inside ring (=5DC, ch.2, 5DC)

R.2: Ch.3 (counts as a DC throughout), turn your work, DC in same 1st stitch (=2DC together), [ch.1, sk 1 st, DC into next stitch] until last stitch, place 2 DC together in last stitch.

R.3: Ch.3 (counts as a DC throughout), turn your work, DC in same 1st stitch (=2DC together), DC inside each DC from previous row until center ch.2 sp.; Inside center space place 2DC, ch.2, 2DC; DC inside each DC from previous row along the side of wrap, 2 DC together in the very last stitch

R.4: Repeat row 2

R.5-34: Repeat row 3, and continue pattern, alternating row 2 and 3 until end of work.

Fasten off, tidy up all loose ends.
