Crochet Easy Boho Romantic Headband with Flowers DIY Beginner Tutorial

Level: Easy

Materials:

1 skein each of Ricorumi DK 100% cotton in shades 011 pink or 032 Blue, 062 Pastel Yellow (or any other DK/light weight size 3 yarn) A 3 mm A tapestry needle A pair of scissors

Abbreviations:

I will be writing in US terms

Ch: chain Sk: skip Sp: space St: stitch Sl st: Slip stitch SC: Single Crochet DC: Double Crochet EOR: End of row

With 3 mm hook and yellow yarn, make a slip knot

Ch 4, sl st into 1st ch to form a ring

R1: Place 10 SC into ring. Pull on center loose end to tighten ring, and if you are changing colour, fasten off.

R2: Sl stitch into any SC, attach yarn; ch 2, yarn over, go into stitch, pull up a loop (3 loops on your hook), yarn over and pull through 2 loops (2 loops left on hook); yarn over and go through next stitch, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through 3 last loops. Ch 2 and sl st through base of stitch (= first petal). *Sl st into next st, ch 2, yarn over, go into stitch, pull up a loop (3 loops on your hook), yarn over and pull through 2 loops (2 loops left on hook); yarn over and go through next stitch, yarn over and pull through 2 loops (2 loops left on hook); yarn over and go through next stitch, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through 3 last loops. Ch 2 and sl st through base of stitch*

Repeat from * until eor, you should have 5 petals in total. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing onto project.

Fasten off, tidy up all loose ends.
