

Crochet Easy Feminine Ribbed Beanie DIY Tutorial

Level: Easy

Materials:

1 skein of Stylecraft Special Aran in shade Cream (Aran/weight 4 yarn).

Substitutes for the yarn: 1 skein of Paintbox Simply Aran

A 5 mm crochet hook

A tapestry needle

A pair of scissors

Abbreviations:

I will be writing in US terms

Ch: chain

Sk: skip

SP: space

Sl st: Slip stitch

HDC: Half Double Crochet

EOR: End of row

Gauge: 10 cm:14 HDC

10 cm: 9 rows

Size of finished project (before sewing) : 23 cm x 46 cm (9”x18”)

Pattern:

Ch 34

Row 1: HDC in 3rd ch from hook (first 2 ch counts as a HDC), HDC into each ch until EOR

Row 2: Ch 2 (=HDC), turn your work; HDC in second stitch and each st across, including ch 2 from previous row at the eor

Row 3-39: Repeat row 2

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing your hat up.

Sew up your hat:

Place your hat on the wrong side. Fold it in half, and start sewing your side seam using the mattress stitch. Once you reach the top of the seam, you will start sewing up the crown of the hat. For this, you will simply pop your tapestry needle in and out of the crown of the hat, at about an inch interval each time. Once you reach the other side, pull on your yarn gently so as to close you hat up.

Make two knots to secure your stitches, fasten off, tidy up all loose ends.
